

## Pupil Premium Report Plans for 2017-2018 Academic year

### A. Introduction

The pupil premium is additional per pupil funding for publicly funded schools in England intended to raise the attainment of children from disadvantaged backgrounds (generally those entitled to free school meals, or who have been so entitled in the last six years) and close the gap between them and their peers. A lesser level of support is provided for children with parents in the regular armed forces. The school allocates the funding received following a needs analysis which identifies priority classes, groups and individuals. Limited funding and resources means that not all disadvantaged children will be in receipt of pupil premium support at any one time. Our very low numbers of disadvantaged children make meaningful statistical comparisons difficult. This document reports on plans for the current academic year. Related documents set out the purposes to which the funding will be applied in each school year and attainment in the previous academic year.

### B. Summary Information

Based on January 2018 figures there were 211 pupils on the roll, 11 (5%) of whom were disadvantaged, and 66(31%) of whom were from service families. Because the funding is given by financial rather than academic year it is not as yet known what the total allocation will be, but £28,125 has been confirmed to the end of March, and a further £9000 or so is expected in respect of the summer term.

### C. Outcomes

Ofsted considers the impact of PPG expenditure on the performance of disadvantaged children but does not separately monitor that of forces children, however the monitors all groups of children. The desired outcomes for the current academic year with an indication of anticipated spend are as follows:
